SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR OVER-THE-COUNTER SIGNIFICANT TREE REMOVAL PERMITS

As determined by Environmental Planning staff, a significant tree removal permit may be available "over-the-counter" for trees which are either:

- Already dead; or
- Monterey pine tree(s) with pitch canker disease or turpentine beetles.

No more than two significant trees in the Coastal Zone can be removed with an over-thecounter permit and must be replaced with a minimum 5-gallon size replacement tree(s) at a minimum of a 1:1 ratio. Replacement of significant trees must be selected from the "tall" and/ or "broad" categories. Oak trees must be replaced with coast live oak, redwood, California sycamore (Platenus racemosa), or Douglas fir.

Submittal Materials

For expedited processing all of the following required submittal materials must be included with the application.

- 1. Two copies of a site plan (minimum 8 ½" x 11") clearly depicting the location of the tree(s) to be removed and the location and species of the proposed replacement tree(s).
- 2. A photograph of the tree(s) to be removed.
- 3. A signed owner/ agent form if the applicant is not the owner.
- 4. Payment for the permit (cash or checks are accepted).

Resource Planners will print the tree removal permit for applicants, if approved.
