BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Senta Cruz:

- 1. That a County Service Area is proposed to be established under the terms of Chapter 2.2 of Title 3 of the Government Code (Section 25210.1 et seq.) in the unincorporated area of Santa Cruz County, the exterior boundaries of the territory proposed for inclusion in the area are more particularly described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein.
- 2. That the name proposed for the area is "BOULDER CREEK COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 7".
- 3. The type of extended county service proposed to be provided within the area pursuant to Chapter 2.2 of Title 3 of the Government Code is:
