PROJECT INFORMATION

1) Does the project include new or replaced impervious / semi-impervious area of <u>5,000 SF or</u> more?

Submit a Final Stormwater Management Plan (see <u>Section II.B of the Design</u> Criteria Appendix D for details).

Submit a maintenance schedule, if the project proposes a permanent mitigation feature(s) (see <u>Section II.F of the Design Criteria Appendix D</u> for details).

Submit a Final Stormwater Management Report (see <u>Section II.E of the Design</u> Criteria for details).

2) Does the project include new or replaced impervious / semi-impervious area of between <u>500 SF</u> and <u>5,000 SF</u>?

No. Yes. If yes, then:

Submit a "Project Information and Threshold Determination Form."

Submit a Final Stormwater Management Plan (see <u>Section II.B of the Design</u> Criteria Appendix C for details).

Submit a maintenance schedule, if the project proposes a permanent mitigation feature(s) (see <u>Section II.E of the Design Criteria Appendix C</u> for details).

3) Does the project include new or replaced impervious / semi-impervious area of 500 SF or less?

No. Yes. If Yes, then:

Submit a "Project Information and Threshold Determination Form."

Submit a Final Stormwater Management Plan (see <u>Section II.B of the Design</u> Criteria Appendix B for details).
