RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ROLLING WOODS COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 10

WHEREAS, a Resolution Initiating Proceedings for the Formation of a County Service Area for Sewerage Services in the Rolling Woods area in the County of Santa Cruz was heretofore filed with the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission, by Resolution No. 228 - LAFCO, approved said formation, and

WHEREAS, this Board, by its Resolution No. 289-70 adopted Sept. 1, 1970, declared its intention to establish a county service area in a certain area of the unincorporated territory of Santa Cruz County, and with proper notice, set Tuesday, September 29, 1970, at 10:30 A.M., as the date for hearing on said matter, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was held at the time and place fixed, and no protests were received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

- 1. That the Board of Supervisors of Santa Cruz County, California, does hereby so declare and determine that , the Rolling Woods County Service Area No. 10 be and it hereby is established.
- 2. That the boundaries of Rolling Woods County Service Area No. 10 shall be as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the services to be performed in Rolling Woods County Service Area No. 10 are as follows:

- A. To own, operate and maintain a sewerage system.
- B. To plan, construct, reconstruct, finance and any other act or function necessary to the furnishing of a complete sewerage service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of this Board shall and hereby is directed to:

- 1. File a proper Certificate of Completion with the Secretary of State.
- 2. Record a copy of the Secretary of State's Certificate along with a copy of said Certificate of Completion with the Recorder of Santa Cruz County.
- 3. File a statement setting forth the legal description of the Service Area with a plat or map showing said boundaries, with the Assessor of the County of Santa Cruz and with the State Board of Equalization.

COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 10

SITUATE in Section 36, T-10-S, R-2-W, M.D.B.& M. projected, Santa Cruz County, California, and being portions of the Rancho Carbonero and the Rancho Canada del Rincon and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern side line of Graham Hill Road, from which the intersection of the center line of Treetop Drive with said side line bears the following two courses: South 19°14' East 100.19 feet; thence on a curve to the right, tangent to the last mentioned course, with a radius of 3,030.65 feet an arc distance of 39.82 feet distant, said point of beginning also being the most vesterly corner of Tract 420 Rolling Woods Subdivision No. 5, recorded in Volume 42 of Maps at Page 39, Santa Cruz County Records; thence from said point of beginning along the boundary of said Tract 420 the following courses: North 52°51' East 283.11 feet (at 232.00 feet the line common to the Rancho Carbonero and the Rancho Canada Del Rincon); thence North 83°08'40" East 149.34 feet to the western side line of Montclair East 149.34 feet to the western side line of Montclair Drive; thence along said side line North 6°51'20" West 357.90 feet to a point at the beginning of a curve; thence on a curve to the right, tangent to the last mentioned course, with a radius of 375 feet an arc distance of 42.11 feet to a point of tangency; thence North 0°25'20" West 18.17 feet; thence leaving said side line North 89°34'40" East 50.00 feet to a point on the eastern side line of Montclair Street; thence South 87°52'30" East 121.95 feet; thence South 4°42'20" East 286.67 feet; thence North 89°34'40" East 115.97 feet; thence leaving said tract boundary North 89°34'40" East 20 feet, more or less, to the western side line of Qak Knoll Drive; thence along to the western side line of Oak Knoll Drive; thence along said side line South 6°25'20" East 8.12 feet to the boundary of said tract; thence leaving said side line along said tract boundary the following courses: North 85°05'30" East 181.70 feet; thence South 4°54'30" East 450.32 feet to the most easterly corner of said tract; thence South 85°05'30" West 202.24 feet to a point on the center line of Oak Knoll Drive; thence along said center line South 4°54'30" Fast 50.73 feet; thence leaving said center line South 85°08'30" West 136.00 feet; thence North 5°00'30" West 28.31 feet; thence North 89°33'West 178.89 feet; thence South 1°53' East 41.06 feet; thence leaving said tract boundary South 1°53' East 40 feet, more or less, to the northwestern corner of land conveyed to Dennis to the northwestern corner of land conveyed to Dennis J.
