FINAL ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND AMENDING DISTRICT CODE TITLES 2 AND 5 RELATED TO "RATE SETTING," "SEWER SERVICE CHARGES," AND

"BILLING AND COLLECTION"

Members of the Board:

On February 1, 2024, the Board adopted, in concept, a proposed ordinance Enacting and Amending District Code Titles 2 and 5 Related to "Rate Setting," "Sewer Service Charges," and "Billing and Collection." This ordinance is now before you for final adoption.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Directors take the following actions:

- Find and determine the adoption of the subject ordinance is exempt from CEQA as set forth in the attached Notice of Exemption and direct the District Secretary to submit the Notice of Exemption to the Santa Cruz County Clerk of the Board for posting; and
- 2. Adopt the subject ordinance, Enacting and Amending District Code Titles 2 and 5 Related to "Rate Setting," "Sewer Service Charges," and "Billing and Collection," and direct the District Secretary to publish said ordinance, or a summary of said ordinance, in accordance with applicable law.

2.04.150 Rate Setting.

The District may, by an ordinanceresolution approved by a two-thirds vote of the Board, prescribe, revise and collect fees, tolls, rates, rentals, and other charges, including connection charges, for services and facilities furnished by it (Health and Safety Code Section 5473).

Article III Sewer Service Charges

5.04.160 Establishment. Sewer service charges are established in the <u>amounts_manner</u> <u>provided for set forth</u> in this article for each facility which has a sewer connection with the works of the District or which discharges sewage that ultimately passes through the works of the District.

5.04.170 Schedule of Sewer Service Charges. The District Board of Directors shall establish sewer service charges by resolution, and in so doing shall distinguish the different classes of service made available and set sewer service charges appropriate to each class of service. Charges may be fixed and revised from time to time with the objective that the District sewer system shall be operated on a sound economic basis.

5.04.180 Residential Facilities.

- A. The sewer service charge for each townhouse or condominium for each of which a separate Assessor's parcel number has been assigned shall be \$861.36 per year.
- B. The sewer service charge for each unit of a multi-family dwelling on a single parcel, for which only one Assessor's parcel number has been assigned, shall be \$861.36 per year.
- C. The sewer service charge for each space of a mobile home park shall be \$738.84 per year.
- D. The sewer service charge for each single-family dwelling shall be \$997.56 per year.
- E. The sewer-service charge for each accessory dwelling unit (ADU) shall be \$861.36 per year.

A sewer service charge shall be fixed by resolution from time to time for each of the following residential facilities:

- A. Each townhouse or condominium which a separate Assessor's parcel number has been assigned;
- B. A multi-family dwelling on a single parcel for which only one Assessor's parcel number has been assigned;
- C. Each space of a mobile home park;
- D. Each single-family dwelling; and,
- E. Each accessory dwelling unit ("ADU").

5.04.190 Commercial Facilities.

The sewer service charge for each commercial facility or for each separate business within such a facility shall be <u>fixed by resolution from time to time and</u> computed by the District Engineer, based upon the previous calendar year's water use (typically October through September, but January through September for fiscal year 2023-24 only):

- Bakeries/Donut Shops \$407.64/year plus \$18.68/HCF
- Restaurants/Catering \$407.64/year plus \$18.68/HCF
- Food Processing \$407.64/year plus \$22.05/HCF
- Funeral Parlor/Mortuary \$407.64/year plus \$22.05/HCF

- Hospital/Convalescent \$407.64/year plus \$14.72/HCF
 Other Business (General) \$407.64/year plus \$14.11/HCF
 Dominican Hospital \$407.64/year plus \$14.72/HCF
- Chaminade \$407.64/year plus \$19.20/HCF

5.04.210 State Beach or Park Facilities.

The A sewer service charge shall be assessed fixed by resolution from time to time and computed by the District Engineer, for each state beach and/or park facility shall be \$407.64 per year plus \$13.63 per HCF based upon the previous twelve-month water use (typically October through September, but January through September for fiscal year 2023-24 only).

5.04.220 School Facilities.

- A. The A sewer service charge shall be assessed fixed by resolution from time to time fixed by resolution from time to time for each elementary school, middle school, or high school based on ADA (average daily attendance), shall be \$407.64 per year plus \$24.63 per student based on the ADA (average daily attendance), including night and adult classes for the school during the school year.
- B. The sewer service charge for each high school shall be \$407.64 per year plus \$36.89 perstudent based on ADA (average daily attendance), including night and adult classes for theschool during the school year.
- <u>CB.</u>—The <u>A</u> sewer service charge for each community college shall be <u>fixed by resolution from time to time</u> \$407.64 per year, plus \$32.50 per student based on full-time equivalent student (FTES), including night and adult classes for the school during the school year.
- <u>PC.</u>. All schools have the option to pay an alternative fee of \$407.64 per year plus \$13.63 per HCFthe annual flat rate plus the commercial rate for hundreds of cubic feet of water used (HCF) if they can provide the District with the previous calendar year's domestic water use (typically October through September, but January through September for fiscal year 2023-24), excluding irrigation water, or provide the winter water use and the corresponding number of school days during the winter billing period.

5.04.225 Effective Date of Rates.

The fees and charges established pursuant to Sections 5.04.180 through 5.04.220 by resolution shall take effect beginning July 1, 2023, or as soon thereafter as the ordinance codified in this section takes effect, following the adoption of the resolution by the Board.following the adoption of the resolution by the Board.

Article IV Billing and Collection

5.04.290 Collection - with General Taxes.

The District may, by ordinance approved by a two-thirds vote of the members of the Board, elect to have sewer service charges for the forthcoming fiscal year and/or delinquent sewer service charges collected on the tax roll on which its general taxes are collected, in the same manner, by the same persons, and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, its general taxes.

The sewer service charge may be collected on the tax roll of the County of Santa Cruz, State of California, in the manner provided pursuant to Section 5471 through 5473.11 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, as amended. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 5473 and 5473.1, a written report containing a description of each parcel of real property receiving such services and facilities and the amount of the charge for each parcel shall be filed with the Secretary of the District. This election may be amended by the District, by a resolution approved by two-thirds vote of the members of the Board.

The Board of Directors of the Santa Cruz County Sanitation District DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section I

Section 2.04.150 of Title 2, Chapter 2.04 of Santa Cruz County Sanitation District Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.04.150 Rate Setting. The District may, by resolution approved by a two-thirds vote of the Board, prescribe, revise and collect fees, tolls, rates, rentals, and other charges, including connection charges, for services and facilities furnished by it (Health and Safety Code Section 5473).

Section II

Section 5.04.160 of Title 5, Article III of Santa Cruz County Sanitation District Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>5.04.160 Establishment.</u> Sewer service charges are established in the manner provided for in this article for each facility which has a sewer connection with the works of the District or which discharges sewage that ultimately passes through the works of the District.

Section III

Title 5, Article III of the Santa Cruz County Sanitation District Code is hereby amended to add section 5.04.170 as follows:

<u>5.04.170 Schedule of Sewer Service Charges.</u> The District Board of Directors shall establish sewer service charges by resolution, and in so doing shall distinguish the different classes of service made available and set sewer service charges appropriate to each class of service. Charges may be fixed and revised from time to time with the objective that the District sewer system shall be operated on a sound economic basis.

Section IV

Sections 5.04.180 through 5.04.225 of Title 5, Article III of Santa Cruz County Sanitation District Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>5.04.180 Residential Facilities.</u> A sewer service charge shall be fixed by resolution from time to time for each of the following residential facilities:

- A. Each townhouse or condominium which a separate Assessor's parcel number has been assigned;
- B. A multi-family dwelling on a single parcel for which only one Assessor's parcel number has been assigned;
- C. Each space of a mobile home park;
- D. Each single-family dwelling; and,
- E. Each accessory dwelling unit ("ADU").

<u>5.04.190 Commercial Facilities.</u> The sewer service charge for each commercial facility or for each separate business within such a facility shall be fixed by resolution from time to time and computed by the District Engineer, based upon the previous calendar year's water use (typically October through September, but January through September for fiscal year 2023-24 only).

<u>5.04.210 State Beach or Park Facilities.</u> A sewer service charge shall be fixed by resolution from time to time and computed by the District engineer, for each state beach and/or park facility based upon the previous twelve-month water use (typically October through September, but January through September for fiscal year 2023-24 only).

5.04.220 School Facilities.

- A. A sewer service charge shall be fixed by resolution from time to time for each elementary school, middle school, junior high school, or high school based on ADA (average daily attendance), including night and adult classes for the school during the school year.
- B. A sewer service charge for each community college shall be fixed by resolution from time to time based on full-time equivalent student (FTES), including night and adult classes for the school during the school year.
- C. All schools have the option to pay an alternative fee of the annual flat rate plus the commercial rate for hundreds of cubic feet of water used (HCF) if they can provide the District with the previous calendar year's domestic water use (typically October through September, but January through September for fiscal year 2023-24), excluding irrigation water, or provide the winter water use and the corresponding number of school days during the winter billing period.

<u>5.04.225 Effective Date of Rates.</u> The fees and charges established by resolution shall take effect beginning July 1 following the adoption of the resolution by the Board.

Section V

Section 5.04.290 of Title 5, Article IV of Santa Cruz County Sanitation District Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>Section 5.04.290 Collection – with General Taxes.</u> The sewer service charge may be collected on the tax roll of the County of Santa Cruz, State of California, in the manner provided pursuant to Section 5471 through 5473.11 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, as amended. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 5473 and 5473.1, a written report containing a description of each parcel of real property receiving such services and facilities and the amount of the charge for each parcel shall be filed with the Secretary of the District. This election may be amended by the District, by a resolution approved by two-thirds vote of the members of the Board.

Section VI

Upon adoption, this Ordinance shall be entered in the minutes of the Santa Cruz County Sanitation District Board of Directors and shall be published once within fifteen (15) days following its adoption in a newspaper having general circulation in the District. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 31st day after the date of final passage.

To consolidate the rate setting process, District staff recommends amending the District code to allow rates to be set by resolution instead of ordinance. The proposed amendments do not involve potential direct or indirect changes to the environment.

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From time to time, County of Santa Cruz (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

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At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. How you must inform us of your decision to receive future notices and disclosure in paper format and withdraw your consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically is described below.

Consequences of changing your mind
