16.2 SCOPING

Pursuant to CEQA, the County of Santa Cruz prepared an initial study and filed a notice of preparation (NOP) that an EIR was to be prepared for the proposed project with the California Office of Planning and Research on January 29, 2001 (State Clearinghouse No. 2001012097). Pursuant to NEPA, the US Army Corps of Engineers published a notice of intent (NOI) to prepare an EIS for the proposed project in the Friday March 30, 2001, Federal Register (Vol. 66, No. 62). Before the planning development permit application was filed, the County held a community meeting on December 12, 2000, where discussion included design elements, environmental concerns, and the next step in the planning process. This meeting was followed by a public scoping meeting, conducted by both the Santa Cruz County Redevelopment Agency and the Corps, on April 12, 2001. This meeting and the ongoing informal public review period (approximately March 30, 2001 through June 15, 2001), fulfilled the NEPA requirement to receive input from the public on the scope of the project, including the scope of the issues to be addressed (CEQ Regs 1501.7).
